Article 5 of the EFPIA patient organisation Code Transparency

a) Each company must make publicly available a list of patient organisations to which it provides financial support and/or significant indirect/non-financial support. This should include a description of the nature of the support that is sufficiently complete to enable the average reader to form an understanding of the significance of the support. The description must include the monetary value of financial support and of invoiced costs. For significant nonfinancial support that cannot be assigned a meaningful monetary value the description must describe clearly the non-monetary benefit that the patient organisation receives. This information may be provided on a national or European level and should be updated at least once a year.²

b) Companies must ensure that their sponsorship is always clearly acknowledged and apparent from the outset.

c) Each company must make publicly available a list of patient organisations that it has engaged to provide significant contracted services. This should include a description of the nature of the services provided that is sufficiently complete to enable the average reader to form an understanding of the nature of the arrangement without the necessity to divulge confidential information.
